KID SCOUTS

WHAT:

Kid Scouts is a six month long community participation and social skills program designed to provide children and their parents with the tools, strategies, and therapeutic intervention necessary to establish meaningful experiences and interactions with their peers in the larger context of their shared community. We are Regional Center Vendored.

WHO:

A child between 5 and 18 years of age who wants to form meaningful friendships and can be safe on community outings in a 4:1 staff/child ratio. Groups are broken down according to chronological and developmental ages. Each group is comprised of 8 children, 1 Occupational Therapist, 1 teacher, and parents.

WHERE:

Kid Scouts will meet weekly for 90 minutes after-school, with at least 1 session per month to take place in the community, and at least 1 session per month to take place in our specialized clinic setting to provide feedback to parents.

WAY:

Kid Scouts prepares children and their families with support for improved independence and active participation with others in the context of community settings.
